Weekly Reflection

"Consecrate them in the truth. Your word is truth. As you sent me into the world, so I sent them into the world. And I consecrate myself for them, so that they also may be consecrated in truth." John 17:17-19

What does it mean to "consecrate" something or someone? Consecration is, of course, a very familiar term within our faith. We speak of the bread and wine being consecrated and becoming the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus our Lord. The consecration of the mere earthly substances of bread and wine transform them into God Himself. Thus, "consecration" is a powerful word. Another familiar use of this word is in reference to those women who have been called by God to enter religious life so as to dedicate themselves to God as spouses of Christ. They become "Consecrated Religious" through their solemn lifelong vows. They are dedicated, taken out of the world and presented to Christ in a unique way. Among the laity, there are many who have consecrated themselves to our Blessed Mother, or to the Sacred Heart, or to our divine Lord through some other special form of devotion. In all of these cases, to "consecrate" is to dedicate, set aside and make holy. Another translation for the word "consecrate" above is "sanctify." To "Sanctify them in the truth" is to make them holy by the truth. This is Jesus' prayer in the above-quoted passage. This line comes from Jesus' beautiful High Priestly Prayer in which He prays to the Father for His disciples and for all who will eventually become His disciples—and that includes you! Jesus' prayer is not only effective as a prayer, it is also effective as a lesson on holiness. How do we become holy? Simple. We allow the Word of the Father to consecrate us in truth. In other words, we allow God's holy Word to engage us, challenge us, change us, call us from sin, point us to Heaven and transform every aspect of our lives. God's Word is the Truth, and we will become holy if we are transformed by this Truth. In what ways do you need the Truth, spoken by the Father in Heaven, to engage you? What are the truths of our faith that you especially need to know, accept, profess and believe? One of the best ways to answer this question is to commit yourself to an in-depth, prayerful reading of the Word of God. By prayerfully reading the Scriptures, you will open yourself to all that God wants to reveal to you. And as the voice of God speaks to you through His Word, you will be invited to change. His Word will combat the confusion and lies of the world and the evil one and set you upon the path to holiness, to true sanctity and interior consecration.

Reflect, today, upon the transforming power of the Word of God. Reflect upon how fully you have allowed His Word to speak to you, call you out of the world, set you apart for holiness and direct you toward Himself. Engaging the Word of God must become your daily spiritual food, and it must paint for you the picture of your glorious life to which you are called.

My Jesus, Word of the Father, You are Truth Itself. You are the Living Word Who has come to set us free. Give me the grace I need to listen to Your holy voice so that Your Truth will engage me in the depths of my soul, transforming me into the person You have called me to be. I open myself to You, dear Lord, and to all You wish to say to me. Jesus, I trust in You.

Abortion: Fiction & Fact

Fiction: Outlawing abortion means pregnant women can't get treatment for ectopic pregnancies!

Fact: Ectopic pregnancies result when an embryo implants outside the uterus - often in the fallopian tube. These embryos cannot survive and often pose serious risks to the mother. Some ectopic pregnancies can resolve naturally but often, a *salpingectomy*, or removal of the fallopian tube, is necessary. If embryo death has already occurred, medication can be used to resolve the ectopic pregnancy.

So, what is abortion? Abortion is the **direct** and **intentional** killing of an unborn child in the womb.

St. Clare of Assisi is a **Baby Safe Haven.**



There is another choice! Surveys have found in the vast majority of cases, women seeking abortion feel under intense pressure to do so. Therefore, for these women, abortion is not a glorious right by which they are able to reclaim control of their lives; instead it is an "evil necessity" to which they submit because they feel they "have no choice." Arizona state law 13-3623.01 provides for the protection of a mother and safety of the baby. It states a parent or agent of a parent can leave an unwanted, unharmed newborn baby at a designated Baby Safe Haven without fear of prosecution and they can remain anonymous.

A baby can be left at the parish office during normal office hours. After hours take the baby to the nearest fire station or hospital. A Baby Safe haven is any of the following:

- Any hospital
- On duty fire stations
- On duty medical technicians
- Designated adoption agencies
- Designated church

"Upon the repeal of Arizona's pre-Roe law, the Bishops of the Arizona Catholic Conference (ACC) wish to declare our firm and continued commitment to serving pre-born children and their mothers. While Arizona is now set to have a 15-week abortion ban be the law of the land, a far-reaching and very extreme pro-abortion initiative is currently being circulated that will determine Arizona law in this regard if it is successful. This initiative, among other things, would likely remove most safeguards for girls and women that are currently in place at abortion clinics, permit a minor to obtain an abortion without parental involvement or permission, and allow for painful late-term abortions of viable pre-born children. We do not believe that this extreme initiative is what Arizona wants or needs. Accordingly, we pray for all those working to promote the right to life and that the initiative does not succeed.

Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord, May 11-12: Worship Aid

Welcome to St. Clare of Assisi Parish! We are glad you are here for the celebration of the Holy Mass. Please take note of the guidelines for the reception of Holy Communion: Prior to receiving Communion, Catholics should have fasted for one hour; water and medicine excepting. Catholics aware of grave sin (e.g. intentionally missing Mass on Sunday/Holy Days, abortion, theft, sexual sin, use of contraceptives, etc.) should go to Confession prior to receiving Communion. Because of our belief in the Eucharist being the Body and Blood of Christ, reception of Communion is reserved to Catholics. There may exist circumstances in the lives of some individual Catholics, which may not facilitate immediate participation in receiving Communion (e.g., cohabitation, marriage outside the Church). A priest would be happy to assist you in rectifying these situations. We come together to worship God in spirit and in truth.
